God is our King Pt 2 Jesus is King eternal

This is our second study on the topic – God is our King. In our previous teaching we established four points – (1) God, whose name is the Lord of hosts, is the King, (2) Israel rejected God as their king, and sought a king like unto the nations, (3) God warned Israel what would come of them under their king, and (4) God rejects their king when their king rejects the word of the Lord. In this teaching we establish an additional four points – (1) Jesus was born king of the Jews, (2) the nation of Israel rejected Jesus as their King, (3) Today Jesus is King eternal, and (4) Jesus will come again and reign as King.

Our four points established from the scriptures –

1. Jesus was born king of the Jews

“Saying, Where is he that is born King of the Jews? for we have seen his star in the east, and are come to worship him” (Matt.2: 2). See also Lk.1: 33.

2. The Jews rejected Jesus as their king

“And from thenceforth Pilate sought to release him: **but the Jews** cried out, saying, If thou let this man go, thou art not Cæsar's friend: whosoever maketh himself a king speaketh against Cæsar. When Pilate therefore heard that saying, he brought Jesus forth, and sat down in the judgment seat in a place that is called the Pavement, but in the Hebrew, Gabbatha. And it was the preparation of the passover, and about the sixth hour: and he saith unto the Jews, Behold your King!” (Jn.19: 12–14).

3. Today Jesus is King eternal

“Now unto the King eternal, immortal, invisible, the only wise God, be honour and glory for ever and ever. Amen” (1 Tim.1: 17).

4. Jesus will reign as King on the earth for one thousand years

“And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years.” (Rev 20: 4).

Illustration

When man-made religions say they believe in Jesus – like Hari Krishna, they believe in another Jesus, not the Jesus of the holy scriptures. Their Jesus was never crucified as King of Israel, raised from the dead, who now sits and reigns from His throne in heaven, and will come again to rapture His church, then return reign as KING.

Question to think about.

What does it mean to you – for Jesus to be King?

Answer from the scriptures

When we pray – we kneel down (Acts 20: 36), we do obeisance to God, the Father and worship Him through His Son who is our God and KING.

He is King of Kings and Lord of Lords.

He will judge the world in righteousness!

Let us Honour the KING, and submit to His authority! Amen!
